Notebook Arrangement:

Notes: This section will contain the notes that you take in class every day; you should have a dated entry for every day. Homework assignments should be a part of each day's entry. Copying notes from another student is only allowed in case of absence, and you must include the name of the student from whom you borrowed the notes.

Vocabulary: This section is for vocabulary and definitions from the literature we read.

Journal: This section is a personal commentary on what we read in this course based on prompts in our textbook or that I may give during class.

Procedure: Journal entries will be due immediately at the beginning of class. I will not ask for these assignments, but will expect you to place them in the folder marked "Journals" that I will place on my desk. All entries must follow these specifications:

- Your personal reaction to the literature. Be honest and specific.
- You should have at least one entry per author. When we are studying a complete work such as a book or a play you should write an entry for every chapter, act, or section.

- Journal entries should be at least 5 sentences and normally should not exceed 1 page. (Although, if you are really into it, you are welcome to write as much as you want.)

After I have reviewed and returned each journal entry, please place it in the journal section.
